• Longer-lasting PE lessons which are organised well and well resourced	Staff will lead more effective PE lessons to pupils due to better equipment and being able to differentiate
• More pupils able to swim due to Year 5 swim lessons as well as top up sessions later in the year	Pupils demonstrating that they can swim and staff to observe and inform parents of progress
• A keen interest in PE activities and the want from pupils to join extra-curricular clubs and take part in sport long term	Progress in how far a pupil can swim or whether they can swim without a float
