### The Halo Code

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## Nursery

In our Nursery, the uniform is the same for boys and girls:

- Salisbury Manor Nursery white polo t-shirt or plain white polo t-shirt
- Salisbury Manor Nursery navy blue sweatshirt or plain navy-blue sweatshirt
- Plain navy/grey/black tracksuit bottoms, shorts, plain navy skirts or pinafores are all permitted. These can be purchased on the high street or in supermarkets. No denim.
- Plain black plimsolls or plain black trainers/shoes preferably with no laces so that children are able to take them off and change them. No sandals. Feet must be completely enclosed.
- During hot weather, children are allowed to wear blue summer dresses and may wear smart navy/grey/black shorts with white polo t-shirt.

## **Jewellery:**

- One small pair of plain studs are permitted. Jewellery worn for religious reasons: Subject to the discretion of the principal.

## **Appropriate religious headwear:**

- Religious headwear can be of any colour.

## **Other:**

- **No** nail polish
- Coats may be any colour, but please ensure they are warm and water-proof
- Book bag or backpack
- Summer and winter hats can be any colour.
- **No** temporary tattoos or henna are allowed.
- Only natural hair colour and styles allowed. **No** shapes/patterns shaved into hair.
- **No** sunglasses, unless for medical reasons as confirmed in writing by a doctor.

Concessions will be made for children with particular needs at the discretion of the principal. We are not responsible for lost property or uniform on the premises.

## **Principal: Ms Emily Curtis**

## Primary (Reception, KS1 and KS2)

- **Shirt/Blouse/Polo:** Plain white collared shirt. Long or short sleeved. Tucked in at all times. Salisbury Manor logo polo t-shirts or plain white polos can be worn too.
- **Trousers/shorts:** Plain navy blue/black/grey tailored school trousers. During hot weather, children may wear smart navy blue/ black/ grey shorts with their shirt / t- shirt.
- **Jumper/Cardigan:** Salisbury Manor School jumper, plain navy jumper or plain navy cardigan.
- **Socks:** Any socks are permitted.
- **Shoes:** Plain black school shoes or trainers with plain black laces and black soles. No sandals. Feet must be completely enclosed.
- **Summer dresses:** Blue summer dresses may be worn in hot weather.
- **Pinafore dress:** Plain navy blue tailored pinafore dress with box pleat or straight cut.
- **Skirt:** Plain navy/grey/black knee-length tailored school skirt.
- **Jewellery:** Silver/gold studs permitted only. No other jewellery permitted (except for religious reasons, e.g. Sikh Kara silver bangle etc.)
- **Outdoor clothing:** Coats may be any colour but please ensure they are warm and waterproof. All outdoor clothing should be removed in the school buildings.
- **Hats:** Summer and winter hats can be any colour.
- **Appropriate religious headwear:** religious headwear can be of any colour.

### PE Uniform:

- **Polo shirt:** White t-shirt
- **Sweatshirt:** Navy/ black/ grey sweatshirt
- **Trousers/shorts:** plain navy blue/black/grey PE shorts or tracksuit bottoms
- **Shoes:** plimsolls or trainers

### Other

- **No** temporary tattoos or henna are allowed.
- Only natural hair colour and styles allowed. **No** shapes/patterns shaved into hair.
